Building	Accordion fold for area between dining room and sanctuary would cost \$1800.00.	
	For drainage issue in the back of the building, building team can dig away from the wall, prepare the surface, and paint two coats with a sealing paint. They could also put in additional drains to act as an overflow. The sealing paint is \$80 a gallon and we would need 1 or 2 gallons. We might also need some fill dirt, which is \$10-\$15 a yard. President approves this work. Call for volunteers to be in weekly.	
	There are two wells where water can drain in the parking lot, but most of the water drains into only one of them, which is why we get so much standing water during heavy rain. A long term project would be to connect the wells via a ditch when work can be done on the parking lot so that the water is distributed more evenly.	
	The sprinkler system in the front is not getting enough water pressure to raise the sprinkler heads. This could be repaired, but at a cost that is a bit prohibitive based on the priority of the project. For now, the grass will have to be manually watered.	
	Following the recent rainstorm, the roof was inspected and no leaks were observed. It seems the roof is much more susceptible to leaking from snow melt rather than rainfall. The hardware can be replaced to resolve that issue, but that may not be necessary. With volunteers, the expense of that repair should be minimal.	
	Cost of building insurance is going up by about 10% this year.	
	Income from garage sale to be applied to flower box in front driveway.
